Roddy Charlton - Minutes from the February 16, 2022 Meeting

Commander Pete Meier opened the meeting with greetings to twenty members and guests. The colors were pre-posted due to a shortage of Color Guard members in attendance. The bugle call "To the Colors" was played and The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Adjutant Roddy Charlton conducted the POW/MIA Empty Chair Ceremony. As the minutes of the January meeting were published in the Post Newsletter, the reading of the minutes was dispensed by the Post Commander. A request for corrections was made by the Adjutant Roddy Charlton and there were none. A vote for acceptance was made and a second to approve the minutes as published. Commander Meier discussed future Post events and American Legion Student Awards. We will continue to support four local schools: Desert Vista High School, Mountain Point High School, Centennial Middle School and Altadena Middle School. Our Post still needs Student Award Coordinators for the two Middle Schools. The Post Color Guard will lead the Ahwatukee Easter Parade to be held April 16, 2022 starting at 10 AM. The Post will provide the traditional hot dogs on the ARC patio for Post members and guests.

Chaplin Rebecca Schmidt provided a prayer. She discussed the Honor and Remembrance Service, to be conducted at the May 18, 2022 Post meeting.

Member Al Hunter will lead an effort to address Post membership. He discussed the formation of a Membership committee with Post members Jack Armstrong and Bill Musik. Al Hunter has completed over twenty seven years as a Lyons Club member and led a team to retain and increase membership. He discussed his approach with the statement "All Post Members Must Be Part Of Membership." Al Hunter will set up a Membership meeting and is looking for additional Post members to join and support this critical effort.

Guest Speaker: Chaplin Rebecca Schmidt introduced our guest speaker, tax expert and professional tax account Ms. Lou Bates. Ms. Bates is a member of the Military Officers Association of America (MOAA) and has been supporting military personnel and others with tax preparation for over four decades. Ms. Bates discussed changes to Federal and State tax laws for 2021. She discussed changes and clarification to Internal Revenue Service (IRS) annual distributions from retirement accounts beginning at age 70-1/2. She discussed the different ways to make withdrawals to meet Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), and tax Form 1099 R, and the 60 Day rollover requirements and penalties. Ms. Bates completed her briefing with a Question and Answer session.


