

The weather, predicted to be rain that would have wreaked havoc with our tournament, cooperated very nicely and we had sunny skies all day. We all gave a big sigh of relief when that happened.

We gave away over \$4,500.00 in prizes in our raffle, and gave everyone the opportunity to win a new Ford Fusion, a new Mazda 3, or a Harley Davidson Black Motorcycle. There were no holes-in-one, so no one walked away with any of those modes of transportation, but everyone had fun! There was a golf ball cannon on one hole that shot the ball over 350 yards. 




